

RENAME tablename, newname

The syntax above renames a table.

- **tablename**: The name of the table with full path.
- **newname**: The desired name.

Practical example

Command:

```
RENAME table01.table10, renamedtable
```

Output:

```
RENAMETABLE ::base => TABLE01.TABLE10, new => RENAMEDTABLE
```

RENAME tablename[newname]

The syntax above renames a table. Use this expression when there are commas either in table name or in new name.

- **tablename**: The name of the table with full path.
- **newname**: The desired name.

Practical example

Command:

```
RENAME table01.table10[renamed, table]
```

Output:

```
RENAMETABLE ::base => TABLE01.TABLE10, new => RENAMED, TABLE
```

In case if you rename multiple tables to one common name the result will be an aggregated view. The same as described in the [ASSIGN](#) page.
